


UNEXPECTED WINDFALL


In farming parlance, "ROWEN" is a second-harvest of hay in one season, an unexpected windfall.






In the far reaches of Sonoma County, high atop undulating mountains around a glistening lake, there is a place, spanning 20,000 acres, where an unexpected windfall has sparked a new approach to winemaking — it's called Cooley Ranch vineyard.

ROWEN Wine Company is built around an indomitable, independent way of life—each bottling encapsulates the spirit of Cooley Ranch vineyard. It's truly unique and one-of-a-kind. In that spectacularly special place, we are stewards of the land of Cooley Ranch where every decision is steeped in sustainable vineyard practices.





EARLY DAYS OF COOLEY RANCH

The story of ROWEN Wine Company begins in the early part of the 20th century, when the Cooley family purchased the first piece of the expansive ranch they own today, which spans over 20,000 acres. Back then the land served as the family's grounds for adventure — they hunted, fished, and ran cattle, getting to know the folds of extreme northern Sonoma County. As the ranch grew, the Cooleys diversified, planting grapes in the 1930s, only to pull them out during Prohibition.

Fast-forward to the early part of this millennium, when the Cooley family focused on protecting and preserving the ranch with a partner. The Cooleys signed an exclusive long-term lease with Tom Klein, proprietor of Rodney Strong Vineyards, to develop the land for them. The new approach started with research where the group studied microclimates and identified more than six different zones across the ranch. Next, they charted elevations and, finally, they called in two of the most respected soil scientists in the world to dig 200 test pits to glean where were the best spots to plant vineyard blocks—this process took a total of seven years.

In the end, the team settled on 200 top-notch acres atop metamorphic, iron-rich greenstone soils and began planting. Some have steep slopes. Others have very steep slopes. The vineyards are at elevations ranging from 900 to 2,040 feet, always sitting above the fog line.

WINEGROWING

Cooley Ranch is truly a unique, remote vineyard. From climate to topography to soils to aspect, setting it apart from others in Sonoma County. As the vineyard sits above the fog line, the grapes have increased sun exposure, which inspires thicker skins. Grapes grow above the hot valleys, they also stay cooler during scorching days, which leads to denser, richer tannins. While most of the vines on Cooley Ranch are Cabernet Sauvignon, the property grows all five traditional Bordeaux red varietals — Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec, Petit Verdot, Merlot and Cabernet Franc — as well as a little Syrah, Viognier and Chardonnay.

WINEMAKING

Instead of following tried and true formulas, Senior Vice President of Winemaking and Winegrowing Justin Seidenfeld leans into the freedoms of blending together different combinations of flavors for every vintage.

Perhaps the most salient characteristic of Seidenfeld's approach to winemaking for ROWEN Wine Company is the fact that there are no rules. He co-ferments white and red grapes. He uses what the land gives him. Much like that "unexpected second windfall", we look forward to what the future will bring to the Cooley Ranch vineyard and ROWEN Wine Company.
